






## West Gippsland Rainfall Outlook – 11<sup>th</sup> September 2025


## **Past Rainfall**

- September rainfall totals have been minimal - particularly in East Gippsland.
- Soil moisture remains very much below average for the season.

## **Outlook**

- 15-20 mm of rain is forecast for West Gippsland over the eight days to 18th September 2025.
- There is about a 60-70% chance of above median rainfall for the following two weeks of September (15<sup>th</sup>- 28<sup>th</sup>)

- The October to December outlook for West Gippsland indicates a 60-70% chance that rainfall will exceed the historical median.
- There are a wide range of possible rainfall outcomes, but model runs are biased towards wetter than normal conditions.
- There is a 75% chance of at least 200 mm of rain over most of West Gippsland between October and December.
