 Feed Planning We have completed a feed budget to determine feed requirements for all classes of stock. We have developed a feeding plan to optimise use of available fodder. We have secured access to quality supplementary feeds. 				
 Feed Availability We have done a stocktake of all feed inventories (including paddocks, silos, and feed stacks). We have consulted with a nutritionist or feed supplier to source alternate feed options. 				
 Feed Testing & Vendor Declarations We have feed tests for all fodder. We have obtained vendor declarations for any externally sourced feed. 				
 Feeding Infrastructure We have appropriate infrastructure for feeding different feeds. We are minimising wastage through suitable storage and feeding systems. 				
 Farm Water Supply We have assessed stock and dairy shed water usage and quality. We have adequate water supply in place. 				
 Irrigation Water We have calculated required irrigation water. We are able to meet the costs of water supply and irrigation. 				
 Cash Flow and Financial Planning We have updated our cash flow budget. We have engaged with our bank, feed suppliers, and key partners to communicate our plans. 				
 Livestock Health and Welfare We have assessed health, body condition, acidosis risk, lameness for all livestock classes. We have a plan in place (cow parking, agistment). We have culled any passengers in the herd. 				
Labour We have adequate labour to support the feeding plan and other drought related activities.				
Wellbeing We are aware of available mental and physical health and support services and have processes in place to support the wellbeing of ourselves, our family, and staff.				
 Grants, Rebates & Financial Support We are aware of grants, rebates, and drought support schemes. We have reached out for assistance with applications.
