Feed planning considerations:

- Feed available (paddocks, silos, stacks).
- · Feed tests and vendor declarations.
- Feeding options considered (incl. external and alternative feeds).
- Nutritionist or feed supplier contacted, if required.
- · Feeding infrastructure available.
- Feeds sourced and contracted.
- · Additional labour required.

Animal health assessment considerations:

- Dairy herd body condition score.
- Cow health (fertility, mastitis, lameness and nutrition

 including acidosis risk).
- Heifer growth weights (% of mature body weight) with respect to when joining is planned.
- · Culling strategy in place.
- Animals welfare and transportation requirements.
- Cow parking options.

The Dry Season Resources document includes:

- Monthly back of the envelope feed budget.
- Feed budget calculator.
- · Cow health and welfare.
- · Stock water planning.
- · Drinking water access and quality.
- DairyBase Budgeting.
- Building emotional resilience.
