The Dairy Business Support Services (DBSS) program offers NSW dairy farmers free access to expert farm business management consultations to strengthen farm operations and achieve business goals.

This initiative, funded by the Farm Business Resilience Program via NSW Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development and the Future Drought Fund, is administered by Dairy NSW.

Key details

Program dates: 1 September 2024 – 30 June 2025 What's included:

- Free one-on-one consultation session
- Tailored business plan
- Group activity session opportunities

What to expect from your consultant

- **Profitability and productivity analysis:** Deep dives into DairyBase and Knowing Your Numbers.
- **Business planning:** Data-driven decision-making for farm operations.
- Farm performance planning: Topics such as HR, herd planning, or data insights.
- Accounting system software: Maximising efficiency in financial management.

Exclusions

- Routine agronomic, veterinary, or financial advice.
- · Accountant fees for tax returns or BAS.

If you participated in previous rounds, this is your chance to focus on new aspects of your business.

What you can access in your consultation

- Face-to-face sessions: Up to six hours of in-person consultation, a one-page business plan, and follow-up support.
- Virtual Sessions: Up to six hours online, with the same deliverables.

Your Regional Representative may attend sessions, providing access to additional resources.

What's expected of you

- Engage all decision-makers in the process.
- · Set aside uninterrupted time for sessions.
- Prepare relevant data and questions beforehand.
- Complete a brief post-consultation survey for program evaluation.

Under the previous round of the program, DBSS delivered measurable benefits:
